That's when Rachel told us a story:



I followed behind at a safe distance. At the door, he looked through the little spyglass thingy, readied the bat, unlocked it, and turned the handle. I was peeking around the corner watching it all go down. He stepped outside, looked around, up and down, and back at the door. Then he called out, "Rachel." "Yes," I whispered. He stood, totally motionless, and said, "Babe, we don't have a doorbell." Even Tucker, who was nearby listening in, laughed out loud.

Sometimes our fears come from stuff that's not really there. Ummmmm — maybe it's the stuff that's not really there is actually what causes many of our fears?

Tucker laughed a long time, and I'm pretty sure that our Abba smiled.
